Polara Golf, the maker of one of the most controversial products in the modern history of golf, has filed for Chapter 11 bankruptcy protection. The Merrifield company — whose legal name is Aero-X Golf Inc. — has less than \$1 million in assets and nearly \$3 million in liabilities, according to a Chapter 11 petition filed Dec. 13 in U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Virginia.
